Representing in Great Britain the interests of the Ukrainian Charitable Foundation 'RIDNYI KRAI', which was founded in 2003 and legally registered on 19 May 2006, in the village of Yasenove, Lyubashiv District, Odesa Oblast, we actively cooperate with Ukrainian and international charitable organizations, including the Red Cross.

For 18 years, from 2006 to the present, the foundations have been working in line with their statutory objectives, taking into account contemporary challenges.

Foundation projects are supported by a large community of people who donate their time and money. The flow of good deeds has gone beyond Ukraine, and the foundations are planning new large-scale projects. Only together we are strong. We invite all people who are not indifferent to participate in our projects. Let us unite our countries through good deeds.

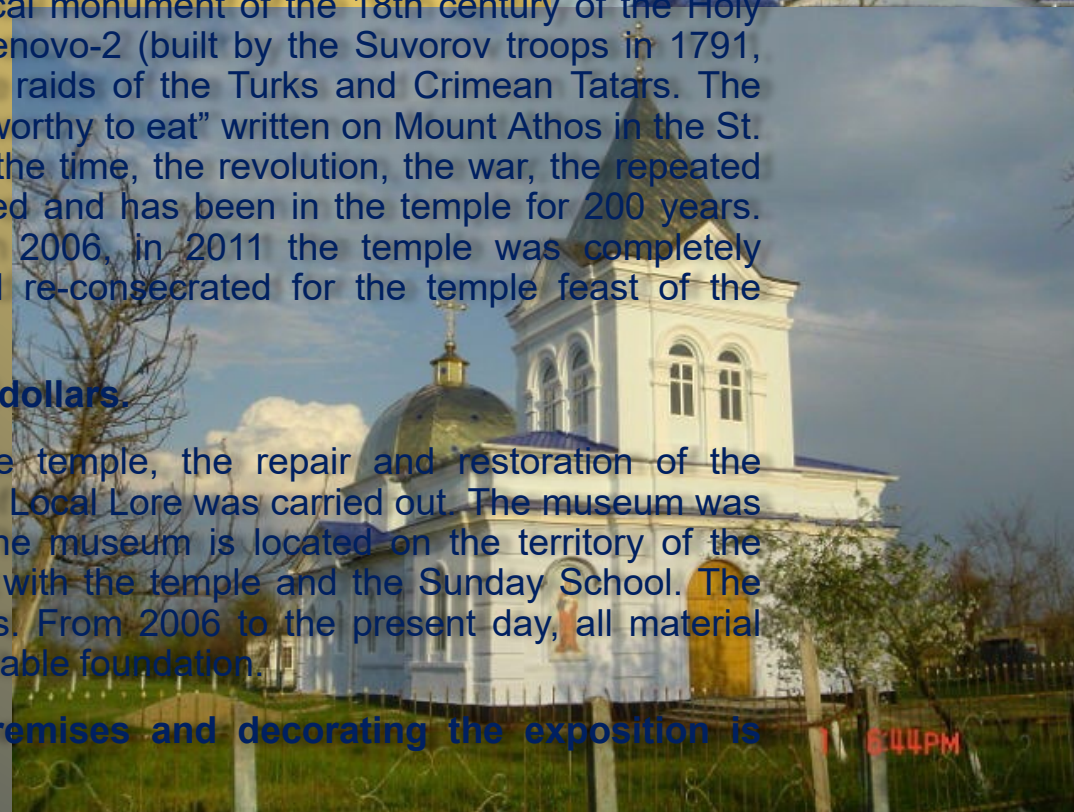
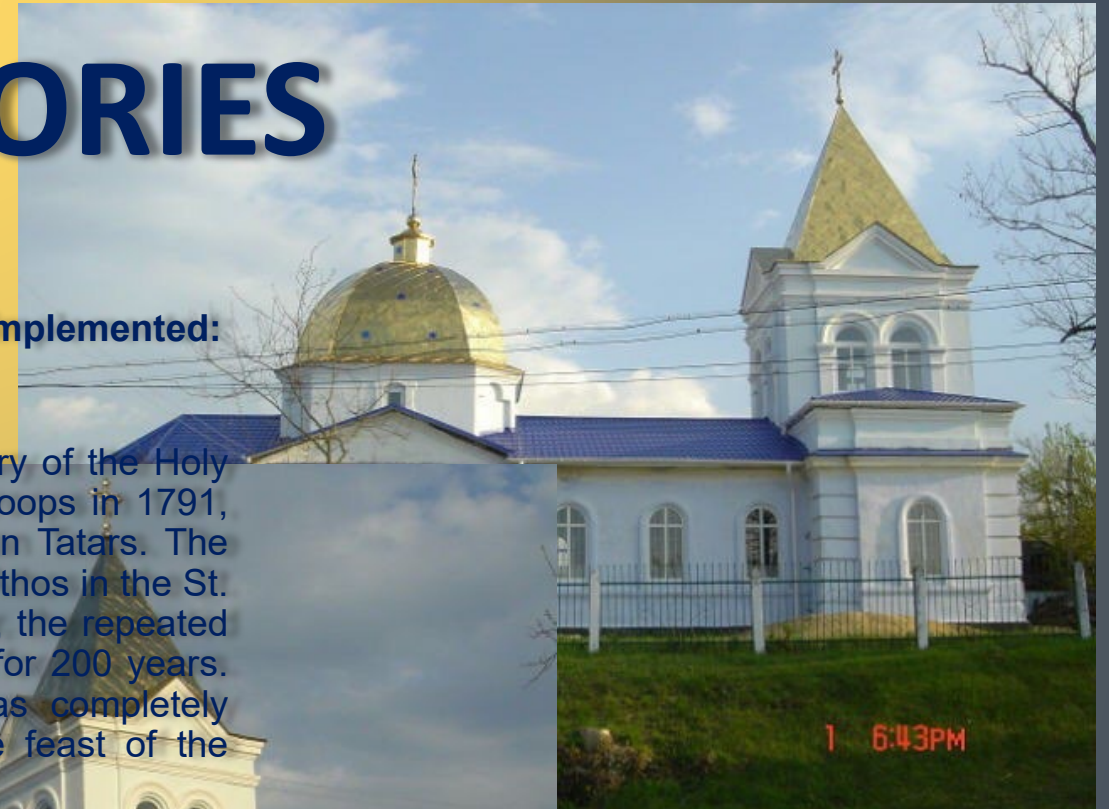
To solve these problems, the following projects were developed and implemented:

1. Overhaul and restoration of the historical monument of the 18th century of the Holy Intercession Church in the village of Yasenovo-2 (built by the Suvorov troops in 1791, after the liberation of the region from the raids of the Turks and Crimean Tatars. The church contains the miraculous icon "It is worthy to eat" written on Mount Athos in the St. Panteleimon Monastery in 1797. Despite the time, the revolution, the war, the repeated destruction of the temple, the icon survived and has been in the temple for 200 years. The restoration of the temple began in 2006, in 2011 the temple was completely restored, supplied with gas, painted and re-consecrated for the temple feast of the Intercession of the Holy Mother of God.

The cost of the project is 250 thousand dollars.

2. In parallel with the restoration of the temple, the repair and restoration of the exposition of the Yasenov Folk Museum of Local Lore was carried out. The museum was founded in 1948 by Rakhubenko S.K. The museum is located on the territory of the temple and is a single historical complex with the temple and the Sunday School. The museum has been operating for 62 years. From 2006 to the present day, all material costs of the museum are paid by the charitable foundation.

The cost of repairing the museum premises and decorating the exposition is \$15,000.

3. Since 2007, a Sunday school has been operating at the church, which is maintained with the help of a charitable foundation and the rector of the church, Archpriest Roman Ivanyuta.

4. From 2007 to 2019 inclusive, on December 19, the charitable foundation holds the feast of St. Nicholas in the Holy Intercession Church in the village of Yasenovo2. The holiday is held for children with disabilities, children from poor families, students of the Sunday School. The holiday has become traditional.

5. Since 2007, the interdistrict competition project "Your talents, native land!" has been successfully operating. The first competition was held in 2007, since then it has become traditional and is held annually by the charitable foundation.

6. Since 2007, the charitable foundation has been holding an annual charity event "From Heart to Heart" in order to support children with disabilities, orphans and children from low-income families.

7. In 2009, the charitable foundation supported the creation of the youth organization "Izvora" and the regional public center "Volunteer«

8. In 2009, the charity fund implemented the youth project of the sports game "Crocus" with the help of the youth organization "Izvora" and soldiers - internationalists from the village of Troitskoye.

9. As part of the revival of the culture of the native land in 2013-14, the charitable foundation restored the premises and updated the exposition of the museum of the world-famous people's artist of Ukraine Rostislav Paletsky in the village of Troitskoye, Lyubashevsky district.

10. In 2019, the charitable foundation provided financial support for the development of the Honey Dew eco-estate and took part in the Honey Dew regional festival in the village of Yasenovo-1.

11. Publishing activities of the foundation:

- 2010-2014 the magazine and newspaper "Ridniy Kray" were published at the expense of the charitable foundation
- During 2010-2019, with the support of the charitable foundation, the books "History of the Country in the History of the Family" were published, this is a series of books from the stories of famous families of the Odessa region for each district.
- A cycle of books "Ukrainian wedding" "Ukrainian vyshyvanka"
- Books of local poets and writers were published.

12. From 2006 to 2022, the charitable foundation provides material support for holding all cultural and sports events in the villages of the Lyubashevsky district.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

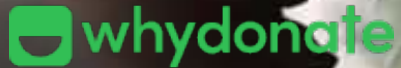
- Humanitarian Aid for Displaced Families.
